Man Has A Soul

There are only two views as to the origin of man. One view says that man is an evolved creature. This view teaches that his origin dates back billions of years to some unexplainable gasses that exploded somewhere in the vastness of space. Molecules haphazardly, luckily arranged themselves in such a way as to produce order, design, life, and consciousness. Life began, we are told, in a very simplistic form. Over time, however, it evolved into its highest form, man. According to this view, man is only
